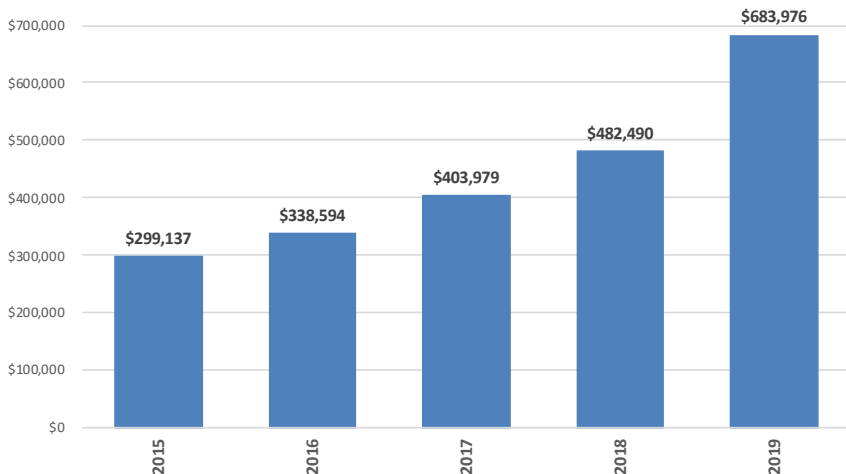

The Birch Creek Endowment generates ongoing support through the four funds identified above. Birch Creek requires a minimum gift of \$5,000 to create an endowment sub-fund that will bear the name of a donor or designee, wherein growth is accrued and reported year after year.

Once the sub-fund reaches a value of \$20,000 or greater, naming privileges become available, such as a faculty chair, staff position, Named Scholarship, or campus structure.

Gifts less than \$5,000 are permanent gifts to the general fund in the Endowment, used in one of the four funds at the donor's request.
