



Summer 2022 Scholarship Procedure

Student/Family's cost for all 2-week residential sessions: **\$2,100**

Scholarship Assistance

Birch Creek has scholarship assistance available to our students based on financial need, merit based, and instruments needed to fill each session. First, the initial student application requirements must be met before a Scholarship Application can be considered. Once accepted, a student may then submit a Scholarship Application (online and PDF versions are available on our website). Scholarship assistance is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are depleted.

Procedure for Admissions

Review of Admission Applications starts on **February 1st**, for all sessions.

Applications continue to be welcomed after February 1st and are reviewed on a rolling basis until positions are filled. *A student must be accepted before his or her Scholarship Application will be considered. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis -- apply early!*

Procedure for ALL Scholarship Applicants:

1. Complete the **Scholarship Application**.
2. Submit the required **audition** as described below.

Percussion & Steel Band – Your placement video will be used for your Scholarship Application.

Symphony – The audition recording (or live audition) you submitted for your Admissions Application will also serve for your Scholarship Application.

Jazz – Students applying for scholarship assistance are required to submit an audio or video audition recording consisting of 2 song selections with a contrasting style. If you were required to submit an audition for your Admissions Application, it will also serve for your Scholarship Application.
